Monmouth's first All-American in lacrosse... Leading candidate to repeat as Northeast Conference Player of the Year... Earned second-team preseason All-American honors from *Street & Smith's CollegeLacrosseUSA.com*... Three-time All-NEC performer... Ranks second in the school's history books in goals scored (138) and points (179).

2000 (Junior): Earned third-team All-America honors from *CollegeLacrosseUSA.com*... Also named Northeast Conference Player of the Year... Tabbed first-team Regional All-America... Ranked third in the country in points per game (5.06) and fifth in the nation in goals per game (3.75)... Earned All-NEC honors for the third consecutive season... Named Monmouth University's Female Athlete of the Year... Set Northeast Conference and school record with 60 goals... Also set school record with 81 points on the season... Named NEC Player of the Week on two different occasions... Started all 17 games for the Hawks...Set school record with 11 points vs. Quinnipiac (4/15)... Also equaled school record with eight goals vs. Quinnipiac... Tallied seven goals vs. American (4/26)... Booked eight points on five goals and three assists vs. Lehigh (4/8)... Scored eight points with six goals and two assists vs. Albany (4/19)... Logged five goals vs. Boston College (3/25) and Sacred Heart (4/16)... Scored three or more goals in 10 different games... Led team with 63 ground balls.

1999 (Sophomore): Earned All-Northeast Conference honors... Appeared in 15 games, all starts, as a sophomore... Ranked second on the team with 44 goals and third in scoring with 53 points... Goal tally also ranked second in the conference... Scored five goals against Drexel (4/15)... Also scored five goals vs. Sacred Heart (4/17)... Booked team-high four goals in NEC semifinal win over Mount St. Mary's... Tallied a point in 14 of her 15 games.

1998 (Freshman): Garnered Northeast Conference Rookie of the Year accolades as a freshman... Started all 15 games for the Hawks as a freshman... Ranked second on the team in goals with 34... All-league performer in soccer with the Mountaineers... Soccer eligibility expired prior to her arrival at Monmouth.

2000 Junior-Mount St. Mary's College: Played in 13 games for the Mountaineers, including two starts... Member of Mountaineers squad that lost to Monmouth in NEC semifinal game... Finished 10th on the team in scoring with 10 points... Also ranked ninth on the squad in goals with nine... Earned second-team All-NEC honors in soccer in the fall of 1999... Led Mountaineers with four goals, including two in a win over High Point.

1999 (Red-shirt Junior-Mount St. Mary's College): Took leave of absence from lacrosse as a junior to study in England... Led soccer team in goals for the third straight year.

1998 (Sophomore-Mount St. Mary's College): Finished eighth on the team in scoring with nine goals and four assists... Member of Mountaineer squad that lost to Monmouth in semifinals of NEC Tournament... Tallied hat trick against Marist... Also scored two goals vs. Quinnipiac... Finished the 1997 soccer season as the Mountaineers' leading scorer... Booked three of her five goals on the season in the second half of a win vs. Wagner and became the first MSMC player to tally two hat tricks in their career.

1997 (Freshman-Mount St. Mary's College): Played competitive lacrosse for the first time and became a starter by season's end... Finished sixth on the team in scoring with 21 points on 15 goals and six assists... Tallied four goals in a win at Niagara and added hat tricks against Wagner and Marist... Scooped up six ground balls in win versus Marist... Also lettered in soccer in the fall of 1996... Led Mountaineers with six goals, including a hat trick vs. Howard... Set single-season school record with 59 shots.

High School: Earned three varsity letters in soccer at St. Rose of Belmar... Named first-team All-Jersey Shore as a senior by the Asbury Park Press and first-team All-Shore Conference by the Newark Star Ledger as a senior... Led the conference with 28 goals as a senior...
